

# Get to know the Danes

Aarhus University along with Studenterhus Aarhus is once again organizing the successful **Internationalize with (Aarh)us**-project, where you as a PH.D. student or Postdoc get a chance to experience Danish culture up close!

**Would you like to meet and get to know a Danish family? Make some Danish friends? Then sign up and join us at the start-up event on Thursday the 3<sup>rd</sup> of November.**

In short, the project is a **dinner club**, where you are offered a **Danish contact family** (a Danish employee from one of the participating companies + his/her family) that can give you a unique insight into the Danish culture outside academia, and where you will also have the opportunity to **share your own culture**.

## Why should I join?

It is a unique opportunity for you to **get up close and personal with Danes** and get a social network outside of your workplace. Past participants have said:

## How do I sign up?

As there are only a limited number of families, we will select among all incoming applications to assure the best matches. You will receive info about your Danish family in advance and meet them at the start-up event on November 3<sup>rd</sup>.

## Practical info

The programme will be from November 2016 until May 2017. The programme includes:

- The kick-off event on Thursday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>, at 18.00 in Studenterhus Aarhus, Nordre Ringgade 3, Aarhus - where you are matched with your Danish Family
- 3 dinners from November 2016 to March 2017, where the Danish family invites you to their home
- One company visit to the companies, where the Danish employee works
- One visit to your workplace, Aarhus University (organised by International Centre)
- The Grand Finale event in early May 2016, which will conclude the official part of the programme

You can plan the individual activities with your Danish match family, but it is a requirement for participation that you can attend the start-up event on November 3<sup>rd</sup>.
